PET-Xi is currently delivering NTP Tuition at Campion School Northamptonshire with 15 groups learners for English and 15 groups of learners for maths.

PET-Xi's core business is tutoring disadvantaged and low achieving KS2 - 4 school pupils, a targeted service we have delivered nationally for 26 years. Each interaction is carefully structured to achieve optimal learning impact to close the achievement gap.

Most of the groups are following a ratio of 1:5 and the programme started just after the start of the academic year. The school engaged with the National Tuition Programme last year working with PET-Xi, the programme worked well and they wanted to continue for a second year. PET-Xi worked closely with Campion School to discuss the programme implementation to ensure all current process and legislation was correctly followed and to identify groups and numbers, select content and appropriate class dynamics.
